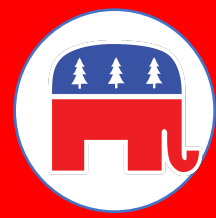


- I. **Welcome** – Jessica Hart Steinmann, President welcomed elected officials, guests and members.

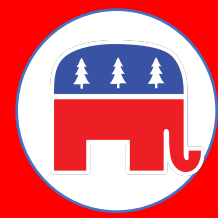

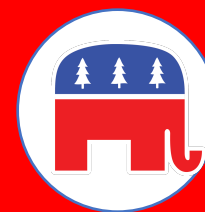
